

Château LE MEYNIEU 2021 HAUT-MEDOC

In the heart of the Medoc, this charming 19th century residence and vineyard nestle in a verdant countryside.

Geographical situation and soil: The castel, bordering Saint-Estephe, is located on clayey chalk and stony subsoil.

The vineyard: Size of estate: 22 hectares vineyard. Grape varieties: 60% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 5% Cabernet-Franc. The average age of the vines is 40 years.

Wine making: The harvest is late to ensure full maturity, perfectly ripe and careful selection of the grapes on arrival at the hopper. Traditional vinification, the must is frequently run-off and recycled to ensure an even temperature during fermentation thanks to efficient thermoregulation. The wine is then aged in oak-casks (30% new each year), for around 14 months. Regularly racked, it is bottled without filtration and stored in the underground cellar in ideal temperature and hydrometric conditions.

Wine caracteristic: All in charm. Beautiful bright ruby color.

Fruity nose, gingerbread.

Good attack, ample and round mid-palate, silky and persistent tannins.

A balanced wine with an obvious aging potential but very pleasant today despite its very young age.

Production: 40 000 bouteilles.
